The Audubon Center

The Audubon Center of the North Woods is a residential environmental learning center accredited by the North Central Association, as well as a licensed wildlife rehabilitation facility. Located in east-central Minnesota on the shores of Grindstone Lake, our diverse 535-acre sanctuary includes a variety of habitats, including old-growth red and white pines, hardwood forests, restored wetlands and prairies. We offer a variety of environmental learning experiences for people of all ages, including natural science, cultural history, teambuilding, adventure programming, and an extensive Raptor Education program. Last year alone our resident birds educated over 6,000 people!

The Adopt-a-Raptor Program

The Audubon Center wildlife barn is currently home to seven injured, non-releasable birds of prey, and takes in many injured and orphaned raptors brought to us by individuals across East-Central Minnesota. By Adopting-a-Raptor at the Audubon Center, you will be directly supporting its care. Adoption donations go towards housing, medical care, food and enrichment items to help encourage natural behavior in our resident raptors.
